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# **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

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The [Free Application for Federal Student Aid](#) (FAFSA) is used to assist with the costs of your education. Eligibility is determined on the basis of your financial need as established by the government.

We have outlined an overview to help you navigate through the online application. You can fill out and submit FAFSA application now to help expedite the process of finding out what you qualify for when you meet with our Financial Aid Administrator at Associated Barber College of San Diego.

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**STEP ONE:**  
**DETERMINE IF YOU ARE AN “INDEPENDENT” OR  
“DEPENDENT” STUDENT**

In this step there are questions on the FAFSA application that will determine if you will need to provide parental information.

**STEP TWO:**  
**APPLY FOR YOUR FSA USER I.D.**  
[HTTPS://FSAID.ED.GOV/NPAS/INDEX.HTM](https://fsaid.ed.gov/npas/index.htm)

1. The username and password you create is how you will sign into all the Department of Education websites and access your Federal Aid records. It is also used to electronically sign your FAFSA application.
2. If you're a dependent student, a parent will need to create a FSA USER I.D.

**STEP THREE:**  
**[COMPLETE YOUR 2017/2018 FAFSA](#)**  
(CLICK ON THE LINK ABOVE)

For 2017/2018 FAFSA you will need 2015 Federal Tax Information if taxes were filed.

**\*Parents Federal Tax Information will be needed if student is considered "dependent".**

**Reminders**

- Associated Barber College of San Diego's Federal School Code is **042425** (so that the school receives a copy of your completed FAFSA).
- FAFSA question #30 - Degree or Certificate you will be working on when you begin the 2017/2018 school year: Certificate or Diploma (less than 2 years).
- Sign application electronically using FAFSA USER ID and password.
- If you are dependent and using parent information, your parent must sign the FAFSA form electronically.
- The deadline to receive your 2017/2018 FAFSA is no later the June 30, 2018.

**STEP FOUR:**  
**COMPLETE ENTRANCE COUNSELING & MASTER  
PROMISSORY NOTE**

1. Go to [www.studentloans.gov](http://www.studentloans.gov) and sign in with your FSA USER I.D.

2. Complete Entrance Counseling & Promissory Note.

\*All Students are required to complete this before receiving Financial Aide. \*

Once you have completed the FAFSA application, the school will receive a copy of your completed FAFSA in approximately three (3) business days. Our office will then be contacting you. If you do not hear from us, please do not hesitate to contact us directly at 619-234-7703.
